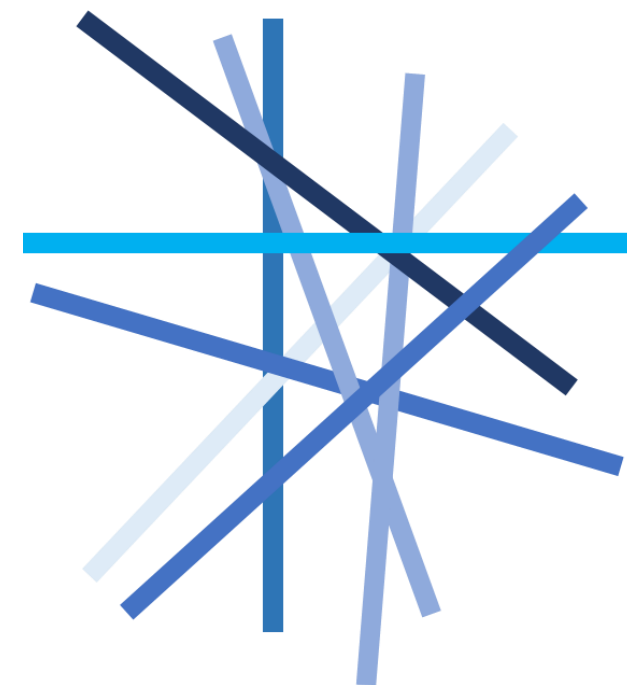

Founded in 1989, by 11 countries with a specific nurse anesthesia education, the IFNA has 43 country members.

MISSION

The International Federation of Nurse Anesthetists (IFNA) is an international organisation representing nurse anesthetists serving the public and its members. The mission of the federation is dedicated to the precept that its members are committed to the advancement of educational standards and practices which will advance the art and science of anesthesiology and thereby support and enhance quality anesthesia care worldwide. The IFNA establishes and maintains effective cooperation with institutions that have a professional interest in nurse anesthesia.

VISION

The International Federation of Nurse Anesthetists (IFNA) is the authoritative voice for nurse anesthetists and nurse anesthesia, supporting and enhancing quality anesthesia care worldwide. As professionals, nurse anesthetists are recognised for their significant contribution to global healthcare as nurses, practitioners, teachers, administrators, researchers and consultants. The IFNA participates in the formulation and implementation of healthcare policy and the recognition of nurse anesthetists as essential and cost-effective health care providers.

The IFNA has developed Standards of Education, Standards of Practice and a Code of Ethics for Nurse Anesthetists. Models of Nurse anesthesia program curriculum have been prepared by the Education Committee. The IFNA previously recognized as Professional Ressource Group, is now Affiliate member to ICN (International Council of Nurse) to be the voice for nurse anesthesia internationally. An international study done by Dr. Maura McAuliffe, American CRNA, for the IFNA has demonstrated on its first phase that nurse anesthetists are participating in more than 80% of all anesthesia in the world. They are the sole providers in 60% of the cases.



CROATIAN NURSES SOCIETY OF ANESTHESIA, REANIMATION, INTENSIVE CARE AND TRANSFUSION

Croatian Nurses Society of Anesthesia, Reanimation, Intensive Care and Transfusion (CNSARICT) was established on May 20, 2005 with the aim of organizing continuing professional development for nurses providing health care in anesthesia, resuscitation, intensive care and transfusion.

Society activities include organizing and conducting professional development courses approved by the Croatian Nursing Council, proposing a scope of work in the fields of anesthesia, resuscitation, intensive care and transfusion, joining international associations, cooperation with related nursing associations and other health professionals in Croatia and beyond, organizing and conducting activities necessary for the Society objectives implementation.

In order to achieve these goals, the Committees for Intensive Care, Anesthesia, Pediatric and Neonatal Intensive Care, Emergency Hospital Admissions, Transfusion, Pain Management, Palliative Care and Hyperbaric Medicine were established.

CNSARICT also pursues its interests internationally through membership in international associations. Society is a member of the European Federation of Critical Care Nursing associations (EfCCNa), International Federation of Nurse Anesthetists (IFNA) and the World Federation of Critical Care Nurses (WFCCN).
